

SOUTH POOL PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday 1st July, 2019 in The Church Village Hall at 6.30pm.

Present – Cllrs. J. Milne, P. Evans, T.Hirst, B. Perrett, M. Warren, P. Wotton and F. Green in the chair. Cllr. J. Brazil. Nigel Toms (SWA), D. Hampden Smith, (F.Responders). A. Lennon (E.Prawle). Sherford PC Representative. S. Hirst Tree Warden, 6 Members of Public.

Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked them for their attendance; he introduced Nigel Toms First Responder for Modbury to the meeting.

Ali Lennon from E. Prawle Fair gave a short introduction to the fund raising scheme to provide a Lifting Chair for our First Responder

D. Hampden Smith who is based at E. Prawle and covers our villages.

Nigel Toms gave a demonstration of the Lifting Chair, explained how it can save valuable time and use of the ambulance on non – injury patients. The cost of this chair is 4,000.00 so fund raising is necessary,

Ali Lennon had an up to-date account of monies raised.

Nigel answered questions from those present, the chairman thanked him for his demonstration, which all agreed had been very interesting and a useful piece of equipment for all First Responders.

The Parish Council then continued with the business on the agenda.

3. Cllr. Brazil's Report - Cllr. Brazil will serve on the Audit committee, Harbour Board and is Chair of Planning following the May elections.

- 9. Tree Planting** – The Tree Warden, Cllr. Hirst and Cllr. Warren have inspected the Jubilee field, it is suitable for planting a community wood. The Woodland Trust is now taking orders for trees. The Village Trust will meet and make a decision on the way forward for the Jubilee Field. If agreement is made for a community wood Tree Warden will order trees; she will also enquire if fencing grants are available.
- 10. Devon Air Ambulance update** – Cllr. Hirst reported they are coming to inspect the field at The Glebe next week.
- 11. Single Homes Policy** – After discussion Cllr. Hirst proposed, seconded Cllr. Evans that South Pool PC join neighbouring PCs and pursue this new policy, unanimously agreed.
- 12. Lifting Chair** – It was proposed by Cllr. Green, seconded Cllr. Perrett to contribute to the Lifting Chair and also to support the First Responder annually, passed unanimously.
