- 5. Public Participation – Pot Hole –** There is a very large pot hole between Devonshire Bridge and Chivelstone – This has been reported we ask Cllr. Brazil to contact Highways.
Footpath 10. – The footpath is completely overgrown – Chairman and Cllr. Brazil to contact Footpath Officer.
Farthingfield Trees – Tree Warden has reported the felling of trees to Tracey Webb, Sheila will forward photos she has taken, PC will contact Conservation Officer and ask Cllr. Brazil to follow this item.
White Lines on The Square – Cllr. Milne will purchase the white paint.

- 7. Chairman’s Report – Seats on the River Bank –** The broken seat has been removed for repair, Cllr. Wotton has a pole to make new legs for both seats. Chairman will contact Cllr. Wotton and a Parishioner to carry out repairs.

- 8. South Pool Village Trust** – Cllr. Milne reported Trustee Steve Dooley has resigned from The Trust having moved from South Pool. Paul Evans will become a Trustee.
Cllr. Milne and Cllr. Green declared an Interest in the next part of Item 8 and took no further part.
The Insurance Premium for The Jubilee Field is due at this time of year – it was proposed by Cllr. Hirst, seconded by Cllr. Perrett to donate 84.00 to the south Pool Village Trust for the insurance premium, passed unanimously.

- 10. Tree Planting** – Sheila Hirst has contacted The Woodland Trust and is waiting for a reply for someone to come and give advice.
Cllr. Milne reported that a decision on the use of The Jubilee Field will be a South Pool Village Trust matter. The field is approximately one and a half acres, fencing and a new gate would be needed if this site is used. There may be a grant available for fencing, there will need to be fund raising.
- 11. Devon Air Ambulance** – It was agreed to contact DAAT and ask them to come and inspect The Football Field.
- 12. Single Homes Policy** – A discussion was held on this matter, it was suggested it might be of more interest to South Pool to pursue the problem with holiday homes setting up a business to get tax relief.
