

SOUTH POOL PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday 3rd December, 2018 in the Church Village Hall at 6.30pm.

Present – Cllrs. J. Milne, P. Evans, B. Perrett, M. Warren, P. Wotton, F. Green in the chair, Cllr. Julian Brazil.

- 1. Apologies –** Cllr. T. Hirst, Tree Warden Sheila Hirst, D& C Police.
- 2. Declarations of Interest –** Cllr.P. Wotton – Item12 Planning – drainage.
- 3. Public Participation –** It was been reported to Parish Council that there is a problem with drainage at Middle Coombe development. There will be no new digester, sewage and gray water will be connected to the old outdated sewage system. This could lead to over loading and an eruption causing pollution to the estuary.
- 4. Cllr. Brazil's Report – SHDC –** a decision on out sourcing the Rubbish Collection will be made at a meeting on Thursday.
The reasons for out sourcing are savings financial and staff.
Questions put to Cllr. Brazil – How will the current staff be employed
Toilets Closure – Councillors have called in the Executive Committee decision, the Harbour Board is holding a workshop to find a solution to avoid closure of the 7 toilets around the estuary.
Harbour Charges – boats will be charged by the length of boat and size of engine, this is to encourage the use of sail and paddles to help the environment.
DCC – have been allocated extra money for roads, S.Pool need to report the subsidence problem at The Bridge to Lisa Edmunds.
DCC is still working on their budget.
It was suggested DCC Highways inform parishes when they are working on their potholes, this would be very useful.
- 9. Sign Post/Communities Together Fund –** Replacement of signs – this was discussed with Cllr. Brazil as Chivelstone PC & E. Portlemouth PC would like to work together on this project. As we are unaware of the needs of each parish and the shortage of time to apply for the Fund it was agreed each parish should apply separately.
It was unanimously agreed South Pool apply for 1,000.00.
- 5. D & C Police Report –** the last crime recorded was in April 2018 there have been only 5 crimes reported in South Pool in 2018.
- 6. Minutes –** The minutes of meeting 05.11.18. were approved and signed.

Drainage on the hill – Lisa Edmunds has this in hand.

Cllr. Green and the Clerk at SHDC.

- 8. Finance- Clerk's Report** – Business Acc. – 9653.69.
Current Acc. – 705.48

- 10. Generator Storage** – Cllr. Milne has met with Richard Jolly, he will build the platform for the generator; it will not affect the warranty on the generator if it sits on a platform.
Cllr. Milne will now contact Rod Matson to carry out the electrical work.

- 11. New Seat at Cliffend** – Cllrs. Green, Milne and Wotton and the Clerk have resourced a number of seats, the meeting was shown details of three seats at Streetmaster.
It was unanimously agreed the Iroco model was the Parish Council choice of seat.
Chairman will contact the two parishioners who are donating the seat tomorrow morning.

- 12. Planning Application – 3655/18/TCA 3 x Alder –Pollard to 6m from ground level. Millbrook Cottage, S.Pool.**
The Tree Warden had sent a report and supported this application.
The Parish Council unanimously agreed to Support this application.

Drainage at Middlecoombe – Cllr. Wotton had declared an interest and left the meeting.

It was unanimously agreed to report a breach of Planning Approval.
