

SOUTH POOL PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the South Pool Parish Council was held on Monday 11th February, 2019 in the Church Village Hall at 6.30pm.

Present – Cllrs. J. Milne, B. Perrett, M. Warren, P. Wotton and F. Green in the chair. Cllr. J. Brazil.

1. Apologies – Cllrs. P. Evans and T. Hirst.

2. Declarations of Interest – Nil.

3. Public Participation – It was reported there is to be a 2 week road Closure at Frogmore with a lengthy alternative route via Dartmouth, Commencing on 25th February.
After a lengthy discussion it was agreed to write to Highways stress the inconvenience to our parishioners and ask for a copy of their Risk Assessment for this closure.
Cllr. Brazil will contact workforce when works commence.
Telephone Kiosk- The light is not working and needs an electrician, Cllr. Milne to contact Rob Mason.

4. Cllr. Brazil's Report – The Community Fund – funds have now been allocated to parishes, the meeting for this purpose of 07.02.19. was cancelled. The Kingsbridge area was oversubscribed by 2,375.00 all parishes were awarded a reduction of 12.2% of each application. DCC AND SHDC are in the budget process at present.
There will be an increase in Council Tax this year –
SHDC – 5.00. DCC – 3% +3%, D&C Police – 24.00.

9. Devon Air Ambulance Landing site – Cllr. Wotton had spoken with a Helicopter pilot re safe landing sites in South Pool, he suggested The Rectory lawn and The Jubilee Field.

After discussion it was agreed to invite DAAT to our Parish Meeting 01.04.19. to discuss their specific needs for a landing site.

10. Communities Together Fund/Sign Posts – Chairman reported the PC had been contacted by SHDC asking if we wished to withdraw The application now that Highways are to replace the sign post at Lee Lane End. The Clerk requested to retain the bid as the parish has a number of other sign posts needing replacement fingers and maintenance. South Pool PC has been successful in the bid 878.78 has been awarded by The Community Fund..

11. Generator Storage – Update – Cllr. Milne reported the hut for the Generator has been completed, the electrical work for the changeover Switch has been completed. The Emergency committee now need to Test the generator. Items still needed for this project – a key safe, Padlock and cage for the gas cylinders and a ring in the wall for Anchorage. Cllr. Milne to source the key safe.
