4. Cllr. Brazil's Report – SHDC – Updates – Primary Residence –

The area for The Primary Residence has now been agreed with SHDC. **Community Housing** – There will be a Public Presentation by SHDC at E. Prawle Community Hall on Wednesday 5th February from 3pm until 7pm. The Community Housing project at E. Prawle is for the Parishes of Chivelstone, E. Portlemouth and South Pool.

DCC & SHDC are working on their budget process, this will mean an Increase in parking charges, the voting on this process takes place on Thursday. DCC have secured extra money from Central Government.

Sign Posts and Finger Posts – Cllr. Wotton asked for advice on Fixing of finger posts, there was a long discussion on this problem.

Climate Change & Biodiversity – Cllr. Brazil suggested a Coleridge Meeting be held in the near future to decide the way forward for our Neighbouring parishes. Our Parish Council has received a letter from A Parishioner suggesting a Citizens Assembly to discuss ways to Improve Biodiversity & Climate Change in parishes, the Parish Council asked Cllr. Brazil to take this idea to the neighbouring PCs. Cllr. Brazil reported Slapton PC are concerned re the resiting of the Slapton Sands Memorial and the future maintenance of the structure, This will also be included on an agenda for the Coleridge meeting. Cllr. Brazil will forward a date to the Clerk if a Coleridge Meeting is to be held.
