

SOUTH POOL PARISH COUNCIL

A Parish Council meeting was held in the Church Village Hall on Monday 5th February, 2018. at 6.30pm.

Present – Cllrs. – P. Evans, T. Hirst, J. Milne, B. Perrett, M. Warren, P. Wotton and F. Green in the chair. Cllr. J. Brazil.

- 1. Apologies** – D & C Police.
- 2. Declarations of Interest** – Nil.
- 3. Public Participation – Marine Plastics – Plogging** – it was agreed to display the notice to encourage people to pick up plastics when jogging on the foreshore, when it becomes available.
- 4. Cllr. Brazil's Report – SHDC** – is setting the budget for 2018/19, there will be an increase in council tax by about 3%. District are to pursue full council tax and charges for rubbish collections for second home owners.
TAP Fund grants have been made to towns & parishes.
DCC – is setting their budget council tax is likely to increase by 6% (3% adult care + 3% capped rate).
Highways – Cllr. Evans reported to Cllr. Brazil the road between Gullet Corner & Devonshire Bridge is in need of repair – Cllr. Brazil will report to Lisa Edmonds but thinks she is aware of this problem.
SHDC – Cllr. Brazil had toured our parish with the Enforcement Team, they had looked at Benches at The Millbrook, Prowses Barn, and the field at Devonshire Bridge. There were no problems.
- 5. D & C Police** – Following an incident in the parish between The Hunt and saboteurs D & C Police were especially asked to attend this meeting, however work commitments prevented their attendance. Clerk reported from email received – Police have spoken with The landlord of The Millbrook Inn re threats made, these were low level threats and no further threats have been reported. Parishioners need to report further threats via the 101 system. Police are not aware of any other issues relating to the South Pool Hunt, but are increasing patrols at known hunts to eliminate fears from all parties.
- 6. Minutes** – Minutes of meeting 08.01.18. were approved & signed.

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7. Chairman's Report – Salt - delivery of salt has now been made to Wilton farm so is available for use.

TAP Fund – we were successful in our application for a grant. We will receive 1,000.00 for the generator project. Chairman will ask for this item to be included on the next Hall Meeting agenda.

Pontoon – the old pontoon has been towed away, expect the new Pontoon will arrive on tomorrow's high tide.

Parking – parking in the main street has become a problem again, Cars are parking by Herons and causing an obstruction.

Chairman will speak with Charlie Baker and ask for a notice to be displayed advising people to park so emergency vehicles have access to all parts of the village.

It was agreed to reinstate the Parish Council's notices regarding inconsiderate parking which can be placed on offending vehicles. Chairman & Vice Chairman to implement.

Village Square – the white parking lines need to renewed, Chairman to contact Lisa Edmonds.

Tidal Road Sign – Cllr. Evans to implement.
