A meeting of the Parish Council was held on Monday 2nd November, 2020 in the Church Village Hall at 6.30pm.

- 3. Cllr. Brazil's Report – Karen Hill delivered the Neighbourhood Plan Leaflets to the meeting, these were distributed to those present to be delivered to each house in the parish.**

Mr. & Mrs Lovett gave an outline of their planning application for 1 &2 Lower Barn and answered questions from Councillors.  - Millbrook Inn – Cllr. Milne reported and distributed a Village Leaflet for S.Pool from the Millbrook Inn listing supplies it will stock during the coming lockdown. The Millbrook will be working with Andie Day's Covid operation as Charlie will be available for any help needed, they will also run a takeaway.**
